RESTAURANT AT TELFORD RETIREMENT SERVICE SCORES TOP HYGIENE RATING

Staff at a retirement service near Telford are celebrating after its restaurant received the highest food hygiene rating, following a recent inspection.

Sanctuary Retirement Living's Lawley Bank Court in Lawley Bank, which has apartments with communal facilities for over 55s and people with long-term care needs, has received a Food Hygiene Rating of five, following an inspection of its onsite Taste restaurant by the Food Standards Agency.

This means that all 24 of Sanctuary Retirement Living's Taste restaurants now

have the highest possible food hygiene rating.

The inspection which rated the service as very good, reflects the excellent standards of food hygiene and safety, as well as the clean conditions of the catering facilities. Lawley Bank Court's inspection report showed a clean sheet, with no areas for improvement, leading to the highest rating of five overall.
